### **YOUNGSTOWN STATE UNIVERSITY RETIREES ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT AGREEMENT**

The Youngstown State University Retirees Association (YSURA) serves all faculty and staff who have retired from Youngstown State University. The organization provides a valuable link between the University and its former employees. The YSURA holds gatherings and other social activities that provide great opportunities for retirees to maintain contact with former colleagues in an informal environment. In 2012 the Association founded this scholarship in an effort to foster student development.

#### **Eligibility:**

- ◆ Minimum overall GPA of 2.7 for undergraduate and 3.0 for graduate degree applicants at YSU
- ◆ Junior or senior student with a declared major or graduate student pursuing a degree
- ◆ Extra-curricular activities, special accomplishments and work experience may also be considered
- ◆ Three letters of recommendation
- ◆ An essay of approximately 500 words titled "My YSU Experience"

#### **Terms:**

This scholarship is awarded annually but is not automatically renewable. Applicants may reapply. This award, when combined with all other financial assistance, will not exceed the cost of full room and board, tuition, fees and books.

#### **Selection:**

Selection will be made by the YSURA selection committee. If future conditions prevent YSURA from making the selection, it shall be made by the YSU Foundation per eligibility and terms stated above.

All growth of corpus shall remain a part of this corpus.
